Official Minutes of the Pierz City Council  
March 23, 2009

Members Present: Toby Egan, Adrian Welle, Stephanie Fyten, Mary Korf, Rollie Hartmann and Maureen Watercott

The City Council meeting was called to order at 7pm at Pierz City Hall by Mayor Toby Egan.

A motion was made by City Clerk Korf, seconded by Councilmember Hartmann to approve the minutes of the March 9<sup>th</sup> meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by Councilmember Fyten, seconded by Councilmember Welle to approve tonight's Agenda with the additions. Motion carried unanimously.

Two interviews scheduled for Chief of Police position with full council for Wednesday April 1<sup>st</sup> 5:30pm and 6:15pm. Council members will submit proposed questions to City Hall by Friday, March 27<sup>th</sup>.

Motion made by Mayor Egan, seconded by Councilmember Hartmann to accept resignation of City Administrator, LindaLee Retka. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by Councilmember Fyten, seconded by Councilmember Welle to increase Utility Clerk, Wanda Lundblad's hourly rate to \$18 and increase her hours to full time until a full time permanent City Administrator is hired. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by Councilmember Hartmann, seconded by City Clerk Korf to hire Aimee Tholen as part-time temporary employee for six to eight weeks at an hourly rate of \$22, as Interim City Administrator. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by Councilmember Welle, seconded by City Clerk Korf to approve Impound Agreement with Morrison County Humane Society. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilmember Welle volunteered to work with Independent School District 484 in developing student community service projects.

Motion made by Councilmember Hartmann, seconded by City Clerk Korf to approve contract with John Rothamel for Electric Rate Study. Motion carried unanimously.

Request from Little Falls Dam Festival tabled for future meeting.

Motion made by Councilmember Fyten, seconded by Councilmember Welle to approve tabling the request from Faith In Action until Mayor Egan has an opportunity to discuss at meeting with Seniors. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by Councilmember Fyten, seconded by Councilmember Hartmann to hire Dan Eastvold as temporary, part time police officer at a rate of \$16 per hour. Motion carried unanimously.

Bob Otremba Public Works Superintendant informed City council that community Spring cleanup is set for May 2<sup>nd</sup> from 9:00am to 11:00am. Amy Kowalzek recommended not doing hazardous waste cleanup.

Daniel Baert Golf Course Manager presented the Park Board recommendations for hire:

Cassandra Kamrowski as beverage cart operator - \$6.55 per hr.

Matthew Pryzbilla as clubhouse staff & beverage cart operator - \$7.25 per hr.


Kayla Rhode as clubhouse staff & beverage cart operator - \$7.25 per hr.
