Official Minutes of the Pierz City Council  
August 23 2010

Members present: Toby Egan, Mary Korf, Stephanie Fyten, Adrian Welle, and Rollie Hartmann.

The City Council meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm at Pierz City Hall by Mayor Toby Egan.

Motion made by City Clerk Mary Korf and seconded by Council Member Stephanie to accept the minutes from the August 09 2010 Regular Council meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by Council Member Stephanie Fyten and seconded by Council Member Adrian Welle to approve the agenda with the additions of the Knights of Columbus Raffle Permit. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by Council member Stephanie Fyten and seconded by Council member Adrian Welle to approve MN DOT Work Order #1. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Mayor Toby Egan and seconded by Council Member Stephanie Fyten to deny approving MN DOT Work Orders #3 and #4 until City Amounts can be clarified and be accurate according to the City's accounts of records. Motion carried unanimously.

Discussion was made in regards to the Oktoberfest Ribbon Cutting Ceremony to be held on August 29 at 10 am at the corners of 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue N and HWY 25. Council Members discussed being concerned that the ceremony was during Mass, however, it was decided to keep the ceremony at the same time since it has been advertised for. Some council members will be unable to attend due to Mass.

An update was given regarding the HWY 25 project. Concrete work would be finished up this week and the final layer of tar put on by the end of the week, weather permitting.

Bob Otremba updated the Council that the new garbage cans would be switched in to the City on September 1<sup>st</sup>. Council member Adrian Welle discussed having renters pay installments to the \$50 deposit, but the Solid Waste Committee decided that a renter would not get the can until the full \$50 deposit was paid.

City Engineer Scott Hedlund was present to state that the final wear course has been put on in Pond View Estates and they have completed the punch list. Scott will bring a form for the city to sign at the next meeting stating that the City has accepted the improvements.


