

CITY OF PIERZ
Official Minutes of the Pierz City Council
February 23rd, 2015

Members present: Toby Egan, Don Bujalski, Steph Fyten, Mike Menden, Matt Bell

The City Council meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm at Pierz City Hall by Mayor Toby Egan.

A Motion was made by Council Member Steph Fyten and seconded by Council Member Don Bujalski to accept the minutes from the February 9th 2015 Regular City Council meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Steph Fyten and seconded by Council Member Mike Menden to approve the agenda with an addition of hearing from Lions Club member Jim Gerwing and resident Leon Flicker. Motion carried unanimously.

Jim Gerwing thanked the council for the contribution to the veteran's memorial.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by City Clerk Matt Bell to approve an electric rebate for the Morrison County Shop. Motion carried unanimously.

A City Council workshop was scheduled for March 16th at 5:00 p.m.

City Administrator Scott Saehr informed the council that he and Mayor Toby Egan will need to attend a NIMS training in order to be eligible for natural disaster funding.

City Administrator Scott Saehr gave the council information about a weed inspection workshop put on by Morrison County that is coming up on March 18th.

The Morrison County Board of Appeal and Equalization will be having a meeting for reviewing and correcting the 2015 assessment year on April 29th at 1:00 p.m. at City Hall.

City Administrator Scott Saehr informed the council that the city has a \$1,000 rebate balance with NJPA.

City Administrator Scott Saehr gave an update on a LMNC training that he and Public Works Administrator Bob Otremba will be attending in April in St. Cloud and requested to take the Public Works truck to the training, which the council approved.

Public Works Administrator Bob Otremba gave an update on the city wide clean-up day; he suggested charging \$10 for TVs, monitors and laptops, \$5 for other electronics, and \$5 for appliances.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council Member Don Bujalski to accept Resolution 02232015-01 approving the appointment of Gina Funk to the City Clerk open position. Motion carried unanimously.


Leon Flicker commented on the uneven heat in the City Hall/Senior Center building and wanted to suggest possibly upgrading the heat for the building.


Police Chief Eric Hanneken presented the Police Department monthly report.
