Official Minutes of the Pierz City Council  
March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2015

The City Council meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm at Pierz City Hall by Mayor Toby Egan.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by City Clerk Gina Funk to accept the minutes from the March 9<sup>th</sup> 2015 Regular City Council meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council Member Don Bujalski to approve the agenda with the addition of hearing from Allen and Jill Dahmen of Pierz Foods and Lloyd Boeder with Pierz Freedom Fest. Motion carried unanimously.

Lloyd Boeder asked the council for a \$500 donation on behalf of Pierz Freedom Fest.

A Motion was made by Council Member Don Bujalski and seconded by City Clerk Gina Funk to approve a donation of \$500 to Pierz Freedom Fest. Motion carried unanimously.

Allen and Jill Dahmen of Pierz Foods updated the council on their plans for a new grocery store in Pierz.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council Member Don Bujalski to approve the updated Annual Designations, with City Clerk Gina Funk replacing former City Clerk Matt Bell on the designations. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Don Bujalski and seconded by City Clerk Gina Funk to approve a gambling permit for St. Joseph's Church. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council Member Steph Fyten to approve a gambling permit for Holy Trinity School. Motion carried unanimously.

City Administrator Scott Saehr informed the council that the city's Pay Equity Report was found to be in compliance by the State of Minnesota.

A Motion was made by City Clerk Gina Funk and seconded by Council Member Steph Fyten to accept Mark Fuhrman's retirement from the Pierz Fire Department. Motion carried unanimously.

City Administrator Scott Saehr gave the council information on a Community Facilities Direct Loan & Grant. The council agreed to move forward with the grant process.

City Administrator Scott Saehr informed the council that a citizen had suggested that the city should advertise the city recycling guidelines. It was decided that posters or flyers would be posted on bulletin boards around the city.



Police Chief Eric Hanneken presented the monthly report for the Police Department. He said that he had received a high call volume this month, with 105 calls for February and March.


City Administrator Scott Saehr informed the council that he would like to set up a meeting for the Finance Committee, with the date to be determined.
