Official Minutes of the Pierz City Council  
April 13, 2016

The City Council meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm at Pierz City Hall by Mayor Toby Egan.

A Motion was made by Council Member Don Bujalski and seconded by City Clerk Gina Funk to accept the minutes from the March 28th, 2016 Regular City Council meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council Member Don Bujalski to approve the agenda with the additions of Glen Martin and removal of Initiative Foundation. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by City Clerk Gina Funk to approve a donation in the amount of \$2,000 for the Legion Ball Park. Motion carried unanimously with Council Member Don Bujalski abstaining.

Don Peine was present to speak to the council about the patio he will be installing at the Legion Ball Field.

Glen Martin addressed the council with concerns he has of dogs being unleashed and people not cleaning up after their dogs. Glen also spoke about the snow pile on the boulevard by clinic. Council advised for him to make the complaints with the police department and speak with Bob Otremba with Public works to address the snow issues.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council Member Don Bujalski to approve the purchase of two new golf carts in the amount of \$3,100 each. Motion carried unanimously.

The Auxillary Club requested use of City Hall May 13<sup>th</sup>, from 8am to 4pm for a set location for poppy day.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council Member Don Bujalski to approve the purchase of a new squad car. A motion was also made by Council Member Don Bujalski and seconded by Council Member Mike Menden to use \$11,000 from the electric fund to help with the purchase. Both motions carried unanimously.

A public hearing for a new rental ordinance was set for May 9<sup>th</sup> at 6pm at City Hall.

A Motion was made by Council Member Steph Fyten and seconded by Council Member Don Bujalski to write off \$1,816.03 in outstanding electric account balances prior to 2014. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Don Bujalski and seconded by City Clerk Gina Funk to approve the Building Permit for the patio at the Legion Ball Field. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by City Clerk Gina Funk and seconded by Council Member Mike Menden to approve the seal coat bid of \$8,830. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council Member Don Bujalski to approve Centennial Drive resurface project in the amount of \$34,048 from Tri-City Paving. Motion carried unanimously.

Parks Superintendent Daniel Baert updated the council saying they are opening the course on Wednesday April 13, 2016. Dan would like to hire Nicole Hoheisel to work at \$9.00 an hour.

A Motion was made by Council Member Don Bujalski and seconded by Steph Fyten to approve the hiring of Nicole Hoheisel for the Golf Course. Motion carried unanimously.

City Administrator Scott Saehr spoke with the council about doing a Farmer's Market. Saehr mentioned that he would like to move forward finding a location for the Farmer's Market and start scheduling for the season. Saehr also spoke about the need for bike racks in the community and requested to start looking for funds to build and install them throughout the community.


A Motion was made by City Clerk and seconded by Council Member Mike Menden to find financing for bike racks in town. Motion carried unanimously.


