Official Minutes of the Pierz City Council
May 23 2011

Members present: Toby Egan, Adrian Welle, Stephanie Fyten, Michael Menden, Mary Korf, and Maureen Watercott.

The City Council meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm at Pierz City Hall by Mayor Toby Egan.

Motion made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council Member Adrian Welle to accept the minutes from the May 9 2011 Regular Council meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council Member Adrian Welle to accept agenda with the additions of the golf course hiring. Motion carried unanimously.

Dennis Welle was present to ask for more information regarding the Safe Routes to Schools program that the City is applying for grant funds to install more sidewalks. His property on Park Ave and Kamnic would be affected and he felt as though putting a sidewalk on the west side of his property would bring the sidewalk too close to the house. The Council took note of his concerns for when and if the project takes place they can take it in to consideration.

Public Works Superintendent Bob Otremba was present to discuss street repairs to Vincent Street. A Motion was made by Council member Mike Menden and seconded by City Clerk Mary Korf to approve the quote from Tretter's for \$3191.50. Motion carried unanimously. Bob also discussed the paving of Vincent Street once the work is done and said Tri-City was the low bid and will do the work for \$6000, which will come out of his budget. Bob also discussed the chip sealing in town and he called for three bids and two came back, with the low bid being Aztec for \$14,862.16. A Motion was made by Council Member Steph Fyten and seconded by City Clerk Mary Korf to approve the bid from Aztec. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by Mayor Toby Egan and seconded by Council member Adrian Welle to approve the Fireworks permit for Oktoberfest, pending approval from the Fire Chief. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Council Member Steph Fyten and seconded by Council Member Adrian Welle to approve the parade permit for Oktoberfest. Motion carried unanimously.

The Council reviewed bids on a new faucet for the Senior Center. They asked that the bids be returned to the Senior Center for new bids that are of the same product from each contractor so that they may equally compare bids. They will review new bids once they are received.

Motion made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by City Clerk Mary Korf to approve paying \$50 to Brian Boser and Dennis Rothstein for the use of their trucks for clean up day. Motion carried unanimously.

An employee performance review meeting was set for June 28th at 5:30 pm at City Hall.

Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by City Clerk Mary Korf to approve the cigarette license for Brickyard Bar and Grill. Motion carried unanimously.


Motion carried unanimously.


