Official Minutes of the Pierz City Council  
May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2015

The City Council meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm at Pierz City Hall by Mayor Toby Egan.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council Member Don Bujalski to accept the minutes from the May 11<sup>th</sup> 2015 Regular City Council meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Steph Fyten and seconded by Council Member Mike Menden to accept the May 18<sup>th</sup> 2015 Special City Council meeting. Motion carried unanimously

A Motion was made by Council Member Don Bujalski and seconded by Council Member Mike Menden approve the agenda with the addition of Todd Preimesberger. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Steph Fyten and seconded by Council Member Mike Menden to accept a \$1000 donation to the Pierz Oktoberfest. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council Member Steph Fyten to donate the use of the Park Shelters for Pierz American Legion Auxiliary on July 16th. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Steph Fyten and seconded by Council Member Don Bujalski to approve Cubic Software Training for Deputy Clerk Kari Tyson for \$990. Motion carried unanimously

A Motion was made by Council Member Steph Fyten and seconded by Council Member Mike Menden to hire Part-Time Police Officer Josh Andrea. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council Member Don Bujalski to accept Resolution 05282105-01 for Part-Time Police Officer Josh Andrea to perform Hazardous work and devote their time and skills to protecting the property and personal safety for the City of Pierz; and provide coverage in Public Employees Police and Fire Plan. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council member Steph Fyten to approve a the annual liquor licenses as follow:

- Brickyard Bar and Grill (On Sale, Sunday, Off Sale)
- Pierz Ballroom (3.2 On Sale, Sunday)
- St. Joseph's Church (2 - One Day Temporary On Sale)
- Legion Ball Park (3.2 On Sale, Sunday)
- Bootlegger's Bar (On Sale, Sunday, Off Sale)
- Lloyd's Liquor (Off Sale)
- Oktoberfest (One Day Temporary On Sale)
- Pierz Golf Course (3.2 On Sale, On Sale Sunday)

Motion carried unanimously.

Public Works Administrator Robert Otremba provided information to do chip sealing for City streets. A proposal from Aztec for chip sealing was presented for \$15,639.00. A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council Member Don Bujalski to accept the proposal. Motion carried unanimously.

Public Works Administrator Bob Otremba informed the council that the 2015 model of pickup he planned to purchase was no longer available. He will inform the council on the 2016 model in June or July.

Public Works Administrator Bob Otremba informed the council that he received a bid for sandblasting and painting the city hall railings and 4 light poles in the city. The cost would be \$750 for the city hall railings and \$340 per light pole.

Public Works Administrator Bob Otremba informed the council that the Lions club will be discussing the water fountain in Billig Park at their next meeting.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council Member Steph Fyten for Police Chief Eric Hanneken to move forward with the application process for NJPA Funding.

Police Chief Eric Hanneken provided his monthly report to the council and discussed the call load comparison from 2015 to prior years.



A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council Member Don Bujalski to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.
