Official Minutes of the Pierz City Council
July 25 2011

Members present: Toby Egan, Adrian Welle, Stephanie Fyten, Michael Menden, Mary Korf, and Maureen Watcrott.

The City Council meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm at Pierz City Hall by Mayor Toby Egan.

Motion made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by City Clerk Mary Korf to accept the minutes from the July 11 2011 Regular Council meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by Council Member Steph Fyten and seconded by Council Member Mike Menden to accept the agenda with the additions of the State Horseshoe Tournamen, August 19th City Hall request, Harvey Britz, and Jim Meyer. Motion carried unanimously.

Harvey Britz was present to let the Council know that he will mow and maintain the Meyer property home place.

Jim Meyer was present to request that someone look in to the location of two bodies that were buried in the old cemetery across from City Hall and currently under the new Thirfty White building. The City said they would look in to researching the location but that the Church would likely have the records.

Motion was made by Council Member Steph Fyten and seconded by Council Member Adrian Welle to approve the Knights of Columbus Gambling Permit. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by City Clerk Mary Korf and seconded by Council member Mike Menden to approve the hiring of an additional part time help at the Golf Course, Amber Priemesberger would be part time seasonal at \$7.25 an hour. Motion carried unanimously.

City Administrator Anna Gruber brought it to the Council's attention that she will not be able to be at City Hall on August 19th and Wanda had requested that day off. Mayor Toby Egan said he would take care of covering City Hall on that day.

Chris Triplett was present to introduce himself and to learn more about the Council and what is going on in the City. He is interested in the Police Chief position.


