Official Minutes of the Pierz City Council
August 8th 2016

The City Council meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm at Pierz City Hall by Mayor Toby Egan

A Motion was made by Council Member Don Bujalski and seconded by City Clerk Mary Korf to accept the minutes from the July 25th, 2016 Special City Council meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Steph Fyten and seconded by Council Member Don Bujalski to approve the agenda with the changes of adding the abatement update, hiring of the New City Administrator, and removal of the Treasurer's Report. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Steph Fyten and seconded by Council Member Don Bujalski to approve Ordinance 1403.04 allowing the City to opt out of the Temporary Family Dwelling, after hearing many concerns brought forward at the public hearing held earlier regarding the new law. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Don Bujalski and seconded by City Clerk Mary Korf to approve resolution 08082016-01 approving TIF 1-10 for the Essentia Health Clinic discussed earlier at the Public Hearing. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Toby Egan and Deputy Clerk Kari Tyson spoke about the concerns brought forth on how residents are charged for mosquito spraying and whether or not the current way is fair. The public works committee will review the current method at their next meeting.

A Motion was made by Council Member Don Bujalski and seconded by Council Member Steph Fyten to approve the electronic bill pay system with fees being paid for by the residents that choose to use the system. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by City Clerk Mary Korf and seconded by Council Member Steph Fyten to approve the fence permit for Graham Hoheisel contingent on a gate being installed so that the grass behind garage could be accessed without having to go through the neighbor's property. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Don Bujalski and seconded by City Clerk Mary Korf to approve the hiring of Nicole Nordlund as the new City Administrator. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Toby Egan updated the council on the asbestos abatement happening in the Old Bank building saying it should be done by the end of the week.

Public Works Director Bob Otremba was present to give an update on the Edward Street project saying paving is scheduled for next week.


