Official Minutes of the Pierz City Council  
August 24th, 2015

The City Council meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm at Pierz City Hall by Mayor Toby Egan.

Deputy Clerk Kari Tyson and Public Works Superintendent Bob Otremba spoke about adding internet via Verizon Wireless to the City Shop. Council decided to move forward with getting internet in place.

A Council workshop was scheduled for September 1<sup>st</sup> at 5pm.


