October 26, 2015

The City Council meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm at Pierz City Hall by Mayor Toby Egan.

A Motion was made by City Clerk Gina Funk and seconded by Council Member Don Bujalski to accept the minutes from the October 12th, 2015 Regular City Council meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

A Motion was made by Council Member Stephanie Fyten and seconded by City Clerk Gina Funk to approve the agenda with additions of the MPCA Property Access Agreement. Motion carried unanimously.

Scott Hedlund with SEH attended the meeting to inform the City Council on the 2016 Street Improvement Feasibility Report. During the presentation Scott Hedlund gave recommendations on the needed repairs for Centennial Drive, Summer Street & 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue SW, 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue SE, , Peter Avenue, and Edward Street S & 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue SE.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by City Clerk Gina Funk to approve resolution 10262015-02 Amendment to Zoning Ordinance 901. Motion carried unanimously.

City Administrator Scott Saehr gave an update on the Senior Center Rental Request for a Cacus Night Event held on March 1<sup>st</sup> 2016.

City Administrator Scott Saehr also gave an update on Babinski Properties and their intentions of building an apartment complex in Pierz. He stated that he provided them with information to conduct their feasibility report.

A Motion was made by Council Member Mike Menden and seconded by Council Member Stephanie Fyten to approve the Tobacco License Applications for Pierz Foods, Red's Auto & Bait, Lloyd's Discount Liquor, and Vet's Super Stop. Motion carried unanimously.

The public works committee meeting was set for Tuesday October 27<sup>th</sup> at 3:45 pm.

A Motion was made by City Clerk Gina Funk and seconded by Council Member Mike Menden to approve the building permit for Jack and Lori Hoheisel on Lot 6 Block 1 in Industrial Park and a fence permit for the ISD #484. Motion carried unanimously.




Public Works Administrator Bob Otremba provided the City Council a 2015 spreadsheet of the Community Gardens. Community Gardens generated a profit in 2015.
