The City Council meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. at Pierz City Hall by Mayor Toby Egan.

APPROVAL OF COUNCIL MINUTES:

A motion was made by Council Kyle Bednar and seconded by City Clerk Dave Fischer to accept the minutes from the November 13, 2018 Public Hearing. Motion carried unanimously.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:


DEPUTY CLERK:
