<p>Newspaper, Magazines, Catalogs, & Phone Books</p> 	<p>Acceptable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Office paper, junk mail, paper bags, newspaper <p>Not Acceptable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Wet &/or soiled material, plastic wrapping, hardcover books
<p>Aluminum, Tin, & Steel Food and Beverage Cans</p> 	<p>Acceptable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pop/Beer cans, fruit/veggie/soup cans including lids.• Must be rinsed thoroughly and clean of all food debris.• Labels do not need to be removed. <p>Not Acceptable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Soiled material, paint cans, aerosol cans, pie tins, aluminum foil, metal toys, scrap metal, batteries
<p>Glass Food and Beverage Containers</p> 	<p>Acceptable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Clear, brown, green & blue food and beverage glass• Beverage bottles, food jars (spaghetti, pickles, etc.)• Glass containers must be rinsed and clean of food debris.• Labels do not need to be removed. <p>Not Acceptable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Soiled material, light bulbs, window glass, mirrors, ceramic, medical waste, dishes or drinking glasses
<p>Corrugated Cardboard and Paperboard (cereal & soda boxes, etc.)</p> 	<p>Acceptable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Paperboard, Boxes, and Flattened cardboard <p>Not Acceptable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Oiled or dirty boxes, waxed material such as milk cartons

Plastic Bottles & Jugs



Acceptable:

- Must be rinsed thoroughly and clean of all food debris.
- Caps and lids can be left on
- Labels do not need to be removed.
- Pop bottles, water bottles, peanut butter containers, mouthwash, salad dressing, milk jugs, bleach, detergent, shampoo/conditioner, butter tubs, yogurt container.

Not Acceptable:

- Plastic bags, jars, pails, tubs, toys, hose pipes, containers that held pesticides, herbicides, solvents, paints, adhesives, or other household hazardous wastes.
- #3 (PVC and Vinyl) siding, vinyl, piping, blister packaging.
- #4 (LDPE) bags, toothpaste, furniture.
- #5 (Polypropylene) typically syrup containers, medicine bottles, plates/bowl, cutlery
- #6 (PS – Styrofoam) egg cartons, meat trays, disposable cups & plates, carry out containers.
- #7 (other) 5-gallon water containers, signs, displays, sunglasses, DVD's

Commingled Recycling:

The City of Pierz uses Commingled Recycling. Recyclable materials may be placed together in the recycling container. No sorting is required. Tying or bagging is not preferred in Commingled Recycling.

Not Acceptable:

Bagged items, plastic bags, Styrofoam, plastic wrap, aluminum foil, medical waste, batteries, light bulbs, window glass, ceramic

Examples of items not accepted for recycling or garbage are TV's, Computers, Appliances (Stove, Refrigerator, Dishwasher, Microwave, Freezer), Tires, Hazardous Waste, Paint, Batteries. These items can be brought to the Morrison County Landfill. Please contact the landfill at (320) 632-1944 for specific procedures and costs as regulations may change.
